This directory lists agricultural products and services produced organically or sustainably in Washington State. The farms and businesses listed in this directory are members of Tilth Producers of Washington, the only statewide chapter of Washington Tilth Association.

While this directory does not include all the organic growers and businesses in the state, it is the most comprehensive list available. The Tilth Producers Directory is available online at www.tilthproducers.org/programs/directory.

Grower Listings

Growers are listed by region to help directory users connect with nearby farmers. Regions are outlined on page 1. Growers may produce some crops and value-added products not listed here; please ask growers for specific crops.

Symbols Used to Identify Growing Practices

This directory includes growers using a wide variety of growing practices. Farmers reported their growing practices in their directory application forms. Tilth Producers does not guarantee the certification of any farmer. We encourage users of this directory to ask growers about their farming practices.

Growing practices listed include:

Certified Organic

These growers have been certified by the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA), or another certification agency accredited by the USDA, for compliance with the laws defining "organically grown."

算 Transitional

These growers are participating in the WSDA Organic Food Certification Program and are in the process of adopting organic practices, but have not completed the qualification process. They are certified by WSDA as Transitional.

• Ecologically Sound

These growers state that they follow ecologically sound practices. Under the National Organic Program (NOP), growers are exempt from certification if they have less than \$5,000 in annual sales of organic food products.

Sustainable

These growers try to use the pest, disease and weed control methods that have minimal negative impact on the environment. They also strive for humane working conditions.

♦ Certified Naturally Grown (CNG)

These growers are fully committed to recognized organic practices, but are certified by a nonprofit, peer-review inspection process.

Washington State Department of Agriculture Organic Food Program

The Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) Organic Food Program started 20 years ago and has been an integral component in the development of organic agriculture in Washington. The WSDA Organic Food Program protects consumers and supports the organic food industry by ensuring the integrity of organic food products. The program is funded by organic certification fees and receives no state or federal funding.

The Washington Organic Food Products Act, was enacted in 1985 and amended in 1987 to implement one of the earliest state organic certification programs in the nation. WSDA's Organic Food Program evolved out of the Tilth Producers certification program, which ran from 1977-1987. In 1988 WSDA began certifying 68 organic farms and a total of 2,000 acres. Processor certification services were added in 1990; handler certification was added in 1992. In 1998 the Organic Program received ISO Guide 65 Accreditation, opening up the program's ability to offer certification to international organic standards. In April 2002, the program

received USDA accreditation and began certifying in accordance with the new National Organic Program (NOP) regulation.

The program currently offers the USDA National Organic Program and international certification services to producers, handlers and processors in Washington State and neighboring areas. In 2010 WSDA certified more than 100,000 acres and more than 1,100 producers and handlers of organic products. WSDA is currently the largest state-operated certification agency in the country in terms of number of operations and acreage certified.

In addition to organic certification, the WSDA Organic Food Program provides registration of input materials through inclusion on an approved list, the Brand Name Material List (BNML). In 2010 more than 600 input materials were reviewed and approved for use in organic production. The approved list is provided as a resource to all certified parties, and is regularly updated on the WSDA website at http://agr.wa.gov/foodanimal/organic/default.htm.

All operations that label, sell or represent crops and products must be certified to make an organic claim. Exceptions to this requirement include organic handlers and producers that sell less than \$5,000 worth of organic products and final retail food establishments, such as a grocery store or restaurant. The WSDA website includes a great deal of information on organic agriculture, including application forms, hot topics and the WSDA Guide to Organic Certification. Please visit the WSDA website or contact their office for more information about the program.

Members continue to serve on the National Organic Standards Board and the Washington State Organic Advisory Board. Working in partnership with Washington Sustainable Food and Farming Network, Tilth Producers worked to establish the nation's first organic agriculture major at a land grant university—Washington State University (WSU), acquired funding to start WSU's Small Farms Program and limited the use of the persistent pesticide, Clopyralid, in Washington. Tilth Producers helped increase the university's state funds for BIOAg research, which increased the amount of money for organic agriculture research for Washington farmers.
